## SCHOOL CCA POLICY



### CCA INVOLVEMENT

School-based CCA is **compulsory** by MOE.

Every student must participate in at least one school-based CCA.

### MODE OF COMMUNICATION

Students CCA involvement/activities will be communicated via Parents Gateway by CCA Teachers.

### ABSENCE FROM CCA

Absence **must be** supported with a Medical Certificate or parent's letter. To be given to CCA Teachers.

### CCA ATTENDANCE

Student **must have a minimum of 75% attendance annually.**

Any less, **conduct grade** will be affected

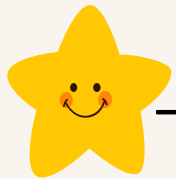

# CCA Selection Process

## **CCA Trials and Interviews –**

From 8<sup>th</sup> January to 21<sup>st</sup> January. Encouraged to attend as many CCAs trials as they can

## **CCA Online Registration Phase via “All Ears Platform” –**

From 21<sup>st</sup> January to 23<sup>rd</sup> January

**Notification of allocated CCA by FTs on 27 January**

## **CCA Appeal Process –**

27 to 30 January. Through FTs. Case to case basis.  
Appeal outcome on 3 February

**Start of CCA on 9 February**



- **Read through the CCA Booklet 2026 sent via PG**
- **Be involved with your child in the process of their CCA selection**
- **Encourage your child to attend the CCA trials to gain insights**
- **Ensure that your child attends CCA sessions regularly**
- **Do also take note of your child's Higher MT lessons and 3<sup>rd</sup> language lessons to avoid clashes**





## **Only for Secondary 1 DSA Students**

- Still submit the CCA Selection form on All Ears platform
- Start CCA from Week 2 onwards
